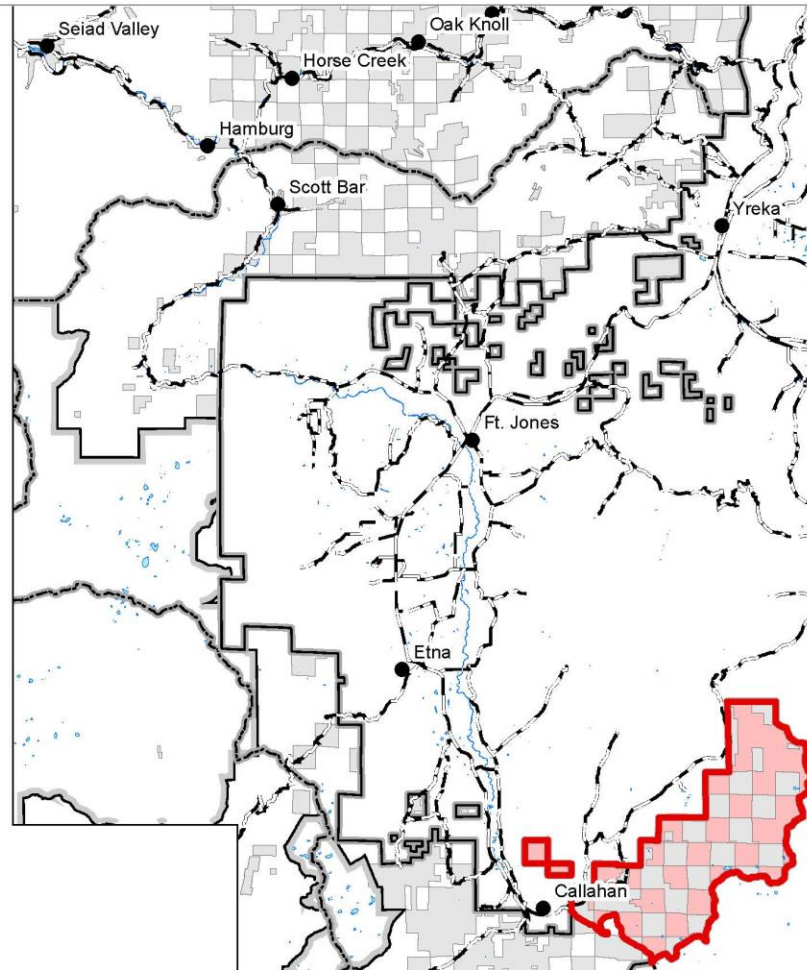


Project Objectives



- Improve forest health and resilience in early and mid-to late-seral habitat

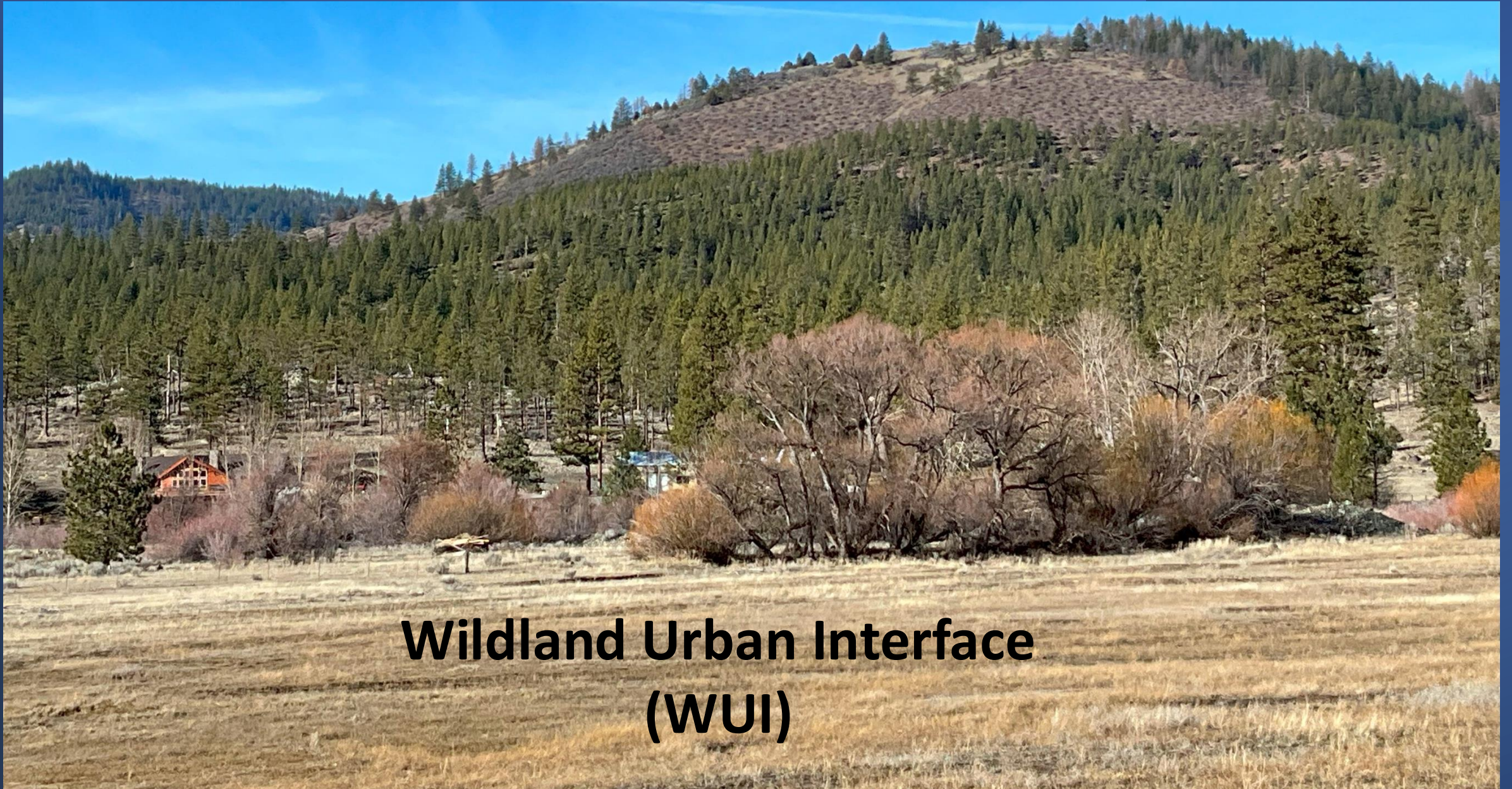


