

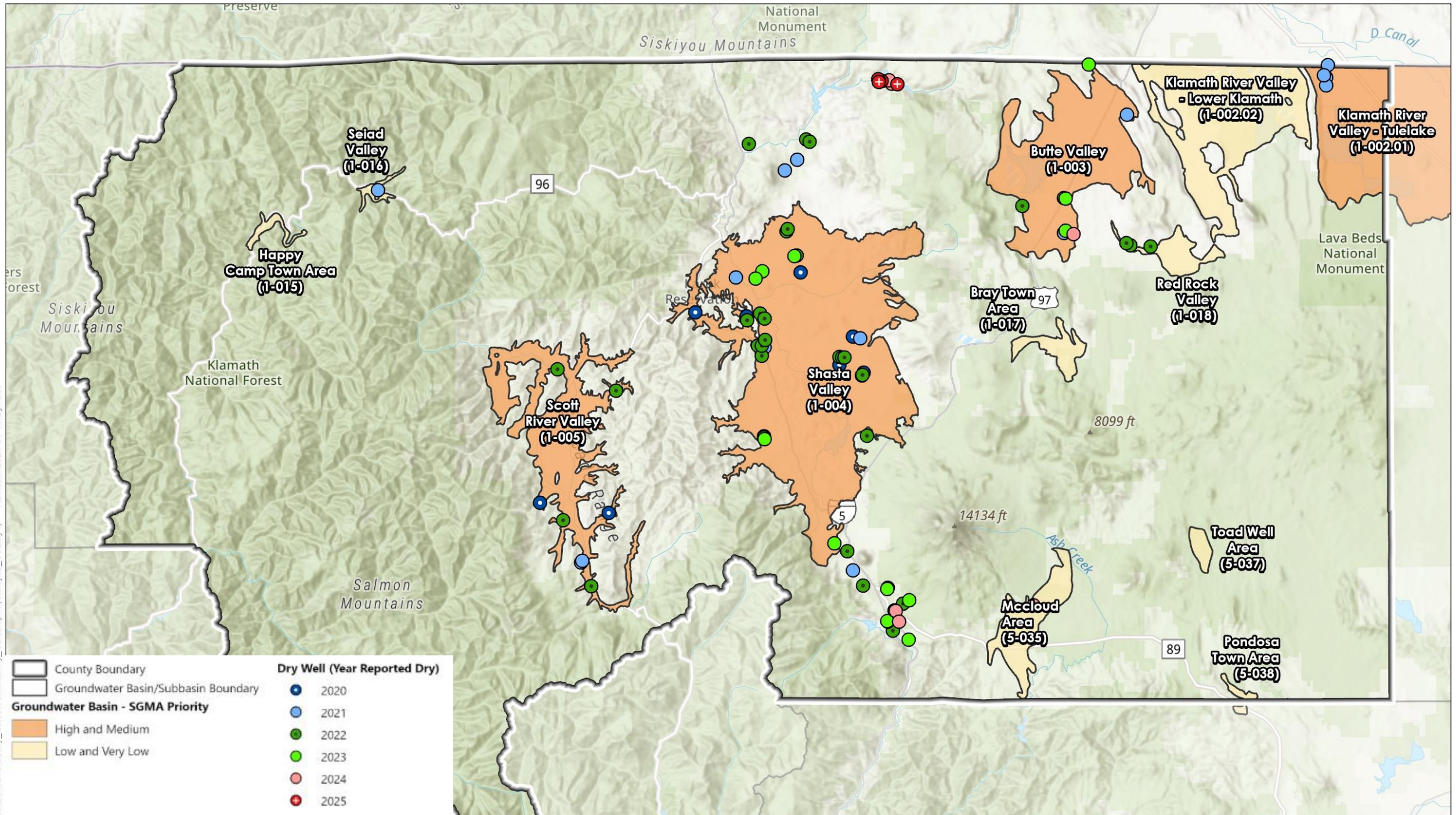

# Drought Resilience Plan Implementation

- Siskiyou OES Plan Updates
- 2021 Senate Bill (SB) 552 was signed into law
- Domestic Wells and Small Systems Water Suppliers (SSWS) support for the County and Local jurisdictions
- SB552 required a Drought Task Force and Drought Resilience Plan
- CalOES grant opportunity
- Awarded and Contractor
  - Partners, Dept Natural Resources, County Environmental Health, CalOES, California Dept Water Resources, and Stantec
